This request for expressions of interest follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in *Development Business* No 728 of 16<sup>th</sup> June 2008

The Government of The Gambia and the Department of State for Finance and Economic Affairs has received a grant from the African Development Fund/ Bank and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant to eligible payments under the contract for **Macroeconomic Adviser**.

The services include:

1. Support the government in the implementation of the Poverty Reduction Support Paper (PRSP) which is called the Strategy for Poverty Alleviation II in the Gambia.
2. Collect and analyze basic macroeconomic and related structural or microeconomic (sectoral) data and help determine the macroeconomic framework on a short to medium term basis.
3. Produce annual policy background papers on current macroeconomic and related structural or microeconomic (sectoral) issues.
4. Work closely with the Central Bank and other agencies in developing coordinated monetary, financial, fiscal and real sector policies.
5. Monitor and support the macroeconomic programs of the donors, particularly the programs of the World Bank and IMF.

Interested consultant/s must provide a statement of capability and experience indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.).
